Level 0 Plans (Community Plans): Does not meet BCERMS (British Columbia Emergency Management System) standards, Does not utilize the Incident Command System. Includes contact information, Hazard Risk Vulnerability Assessment (HRVA), evacuation plan, and community demographics.

Level 1 Plans (Basic Emergency Plan): include emergency contact information, community context, emergency plan authority and activation procedures, emergency response and recovery structure outline, probable hazards with emergency contacts, Emergency Social Services (ESS) capacity overview, basic recovery roles and procedures, general evacuation plans, EOC position lists and descriptions, EOC forms.

Level 2 Plans (Evolving Emergency Plan): include emergency contact information, community context, emergency plan authority and activation procedures, emergency response and recovery structure outline, **assigned EOC staff**, hazards matrix with emergency contacts and **hazard action plans**, Emergency Social Services (ESS) capacity overview, basic recovery roles and procedures, general evacuation plans, EOC position lists and descriptions, EOC forms.

Level 3 Plans (Comprehensive Emergency Plan): Includes emergency contact information, Community context, Emergency plan authority and activation procedures, Emergency response and recovery structure outline, Hazards matrix with emergency contacts, Emergency Social Services (ESS) capacity overview, Basic recovery roles and procedures, general evacuation plans, EOC position lists and descriptions, EOC forms, Hazard specific action plans, **Detail & Evolving plan**, Trained EM personnel, Assigned EOC staff, **Comprehensive 2 year training exercise schedule** and Aggressive updating schedule.
